1. Empty Gravel City Hall Parking Lot Usage for 2021

Alderman Koffler opened the City Buildings/Street Lighting Committee Meeting to discuss Haley Mindt and Ashlee Sheehan to use the empty gravel city hall parking lot for selling fireworks at their fireworks trailer this year. Alderman Koffler mentioned that the city should allow Haley Mindt and Ashlee Sheehan to use the lot again this year, and Alderwoman Christensen agreed to that statement. Alderwoman Christensen stated that she would not like to see them or anyone else use the city's lot next year though with the new clock being installed on that lot. Alderwoman Christensen made a motion to approve of Haley Mindt and Ashlee Sheehan to use the city's gravel parking lot again this year for their fireworks trailer but, next year no one is allowed on that lot. Alderman Koffler seconded the motion, Ms. Mindt stated that she will provide the city a copy of her insurance policy and try to get it to city hall tomorrow. Ms. Mindt also asked if she would be able to set up her fireworks stand on June 25th, 2021, and start selling fireworks on June 27th, 2021, Mayor Norby mentioned that would be totally acceptable. Chief Kraft stated that he would not like to see any discharging of fireworks near their trailer from any buyers or sellers this year, and Ms. Midnt stated that she would not let that happen. After no further discussion, all present voted aye.
